

ANNUAL REDNECK REGATTA RULES

Saturday, July 1st, 2023

1:00 pm @ Jayhawk Marina

- 1) Contest is open to the public – Age 12 and over.
- 2) All boats/rafts must be homemade.
- 3) No commercially manufactured hulls.
- 4) Inner tube flotation is approved if it supports a raft or boat deck.
- 5) Must be self-propelled (poles, sail, oars, paddlewheel, etc) NO MOTORS
- 6) Nails are prohibited below the deck line.
- 7) Rafts are encouraged to affix styrofoam for flotation.
- 8) Aftermarket marine rigging is acceptable.
- 9) Crew size = minimum 2 to 4 maximum.
- 10) All participants must wear Coast Guard approved PFD.
- 11) All boats/rafts must have a 50' tow rope attached to the hull.
- 12) Sheet metal or raw edges must be taped or rounded.
- 13) Shoes or wet socks are encouraged.
- 14) All entries must check in and be inspected prior to launching and will be subject to disqualification at the discretion of the Judges.
- 15) Crews will race approximately 100 yards around a buoy and return to finish line. All crewmembers must be on board to finish.
- 16) Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, as well as awards for Best Original Design/ Theme/ Uniqueness & Best Team Effort (t-shirts, cheerleaders, costumes, etc.,)
- 17) Contestants release Jayhawk Marina, Inc from any claim, demand or course of action for personal injury, death, property loss, destruction or theft and must sign a waiver prior to participating.
- 18) Participants are responsible for removing boat/raft or parts thereof from Marina and State Park after the race.
- 19) There will be a mandatory Captain's Meeting one 30 minutes prior to race time.
- 20) Contest entry constitutes release to use contestant's name, photo and/or voice in broadcast or print material.
